- 1. Two Midland Empire Chapter Scholarship awards will be granted in the amount of \$2,500 each.
- 2. Eligibility: The applicant must be a member of a Credit Union within the Midland Empire Chapter fields of membership. These scholarships apply to any accredited college, graduate school, or secondary education facility.
- 3. Traditional Student Scholarship: One scholarship will be awarded to a traditional student, defined as a graduating high school senior or someone in college with less than a three-year gap since high school. Ray Harris Memorial Scholarship: One scholarship will be awarded to a non-traditional student, defined as someone who was out of school for at least three years and has returned.
- 4. Due Date: Completed applications and all required materials must be submitted to your credit union no later than March 1st. Scholarships will be awarded at the April chapter meeting of the Midland Empire Chapter of Credit Unions.

	<ul> <li>Completed and signed application form (signature line on Page 3).</li> <li>Two letters of recommendation from non-relatives who can attest to your character and to your desire to continue your education. If you are currently enrolled in a school, one letter should be from a faculty member.</li> <li>A copy of your most recent school grade transcript.</li> <li>A photo of the scholarship applicant for publicity purposes if the applicant is awarded a scholarship.</li> <li>A brief letter, not to exceed 300 words, addressing the following: <ul> <li>Your need for a scholarship and how a scholarship would benefit you.</li> <li>A statement of your educational goals.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	Include any additional information you would like the scholarship committee to consider.
