


Bank Worldwide

Fraudsters have placed a fake ad on Facebook claiming to be advertising for "Dr. Pepper" and looking for people to be part of their advertising team. If you respond, they send you a fraudulent "official check" and ask you to deposit it in your account and email them a copy of your deposit slip, which gives the scammer your account number.
